

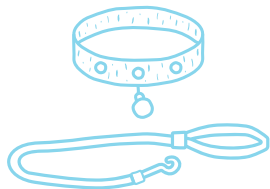
# DOGS AT WORK

## WHAT TO BRING



### Personalised Dog Tag

Keep them safe with a cute & durable Dog Tag including your details.



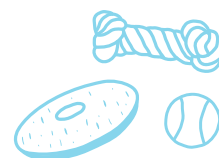
### Collar & Leash

Avoid restlessness & bring their favourite toys + an extra for sharing.



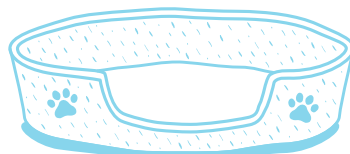
### Water & Food Bowls

## RULES TO ESTABLISH

- 1 Take dogs out for bathroom breaks routinely.

- 4 Ensure vaccinations are up to date.
- 5 Introduce new dogs to each other in a neutral area (eg. outside).
